### Big Dig Comes to Crestwood

You've likely noticed the heavy equipment operating near 55th and Oak Streets. The work is being undertaken as part of the 5-phase Brookside Watershed Improvement Program. The program is a public investment of more than \$50 million to reduce flooding and sewer back-ups. The project is being funded through city sales tax dollars through the Public Improvement Advisory Committee (PIAC), revenue from sewer fees, and through the State of Missouri Revolving Loan fund.



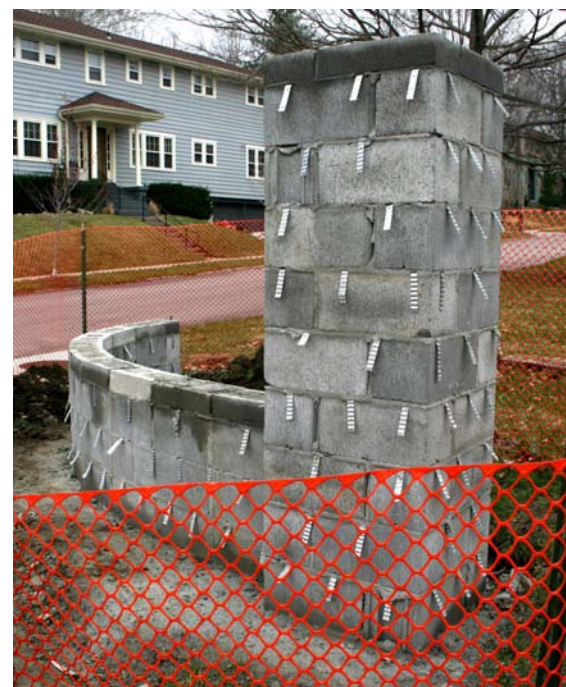
Phase 4 of the program focuses on Crestwood. In the coming months crews will replace additional street catch basins and enlarge the storm drainage and sanitary sewer systems at an approximate cost of \$6.5 million. The work in our neighborhood is scheduled to be complete in Spring 2008.
